WANTED: FOUNDERS

The community at Got Matar is building a secondary school for 600 boys and girls who could not otherwise continue education. Got Matar is in one of poorest rural parts of Kenya, and one in three children is an orphan. The four year project will cost £200,000.

Six months in, we have raised over £50,000. With this and strong local leadership, fine new facilities have been built and nearly 150 pupils are already in school. The next steps are more classrooms, a science lab, workshops to learn practical skills, computers, rainwater storage, solar power, text books and bursaries for orphans.

The community is managing the project with support from PEAS, an experienced UK school-building charity. All vacancies for builders, teachers and pupils are filled, but we still need more founders.
